Individual Licenses of DEEM™ - FCID Version 2.14 and CALENDEX™ - FCID Version 3.3 Now Available

In response to public demands and changing regulatory requirements, Exponent has decided to make DEEM™ - FCID and CALENDEX™ much more widely available and to do so at a nominal cost. Both programs are now available for licensing and use by any individual who purchases a license. The license will be an annual license and the fee will cover production, shipping and handling costs. The license fee for 2009 will be \$500 per license for each program.

The versions of DEEM™ - FCID and CALENDEX™ - FCID licensed to individuals will be the same full-featured versions currently licensed to EPA, Canada, California EPA and other organizations. However, the license will be issued to an individual for use on one computer only. Analyses conducted with the software can be used for any legitimate scientific, academic, business or regulatory purpose but the reports produced by the software are not to be modified without written permission from Exponent.

Any organization may purchase licenses for multiple individuals but the license is not transferable, e.g. the license will designate the specific licensee and that person will not be authorized to transfer the license to another individual.

SOFTWARE DESCRIPTION

DEEM™ - FCID provides the user with the tools necessary to conduct detailed analyses of dietary exposure using the USDA Food Continuing Surveys of Food Intake by Individuals (CSFII 1994-1996, 1998) and the EPA Food Commodity Ingredient Database (FCID) in conjunction with user-friendly interfaces for selecting analysis options and for entering data. DEEM™ - FCID includes options for conducting Monte-Carlo assessments and for determining the source contributions through the Critical Exposure Contribution (CEC) module. The DEEM™ - FCID software has been peer reviewed by the EPA Science Advisory Panel.

CALENDEX™ - FCID allows the user to conduct aggregate and cumulative exposure assessments for a wide variety of consumer residential exposure scenarios including those specified under the Food Quality Protection Act (FQPA). (Individuals wishing to include the dietary route in their analysis must also license DEEM™ - FCID). The CALENDEX™ - FCID software has been peer reviewed by the EPA Science Advisory Panel.

LICENSING PROCEDURE

Individuals desiring to license the software may do so by completing the enclosed agreement and returning it with a check or purchase order (made out to Exponent) for the full license fees, plus any state sales tax. You may also fax us a copy of the signed license agreement and purchase with a credit card over the phone (we accept Visa, Master Card, and American Express).

If the licensee desires, technical support, workshops and periodic updates can be obtained through Exponent's standard contracting fees.
